

2008 NATIVE PLANT SALE & AUCTION

The 2008 Native Plant Sale and Auction will be at a new location. The larger space and improved parking available for the sale at Trinity/St. Richard's, 3243 N. Meridian St. in Indianapolis, will allow the sale to offer even more great native plants, shrubs and trees for area gardeners. **The 2008 sale will be held Saturday, May 10, 10:00–12:30.**

The plant sale will begin at 10:00, with the auction starting at 11:15. All sale plants still remaining by about 12:15 will be sold as the last items of the auction. A selection of books on native plant gardening, wildflowers, and other nature related topics will again be available for sale, but an added benefit of the larger space is that they will no longer need to be sold in a separate room. Books will now be available throughout the plant sale and auction.

Plants at the sale are a combination of plants donated by INPAWS members from their own gardens or raised from seed, plants donated by nurseries that specialize in native plants, and plants dug at “rescues.” Rescued plants are dug by members (with the permission of the owner) from sites that are scheduled for construction.

The auction includes larger or more unusual specimens of native plants, shrubs and trees. Even if you don't purchase anything during the auction, it is always a fun and informative event to watch.
